Project History

- July 2010: IAVM Foundation grant of \$650K launches the project
- August October 2010: Platform host selected
- November 2010 January 2011: Testing and validating data collection platform and process
- February 2011: Data collection launches



Project Cycle

- Data collection surveys released quarterly
- Reports available 60 days after survey closes
- Executive summary published in Facility Manager 90 days after survey closes
- Presentations developed for conferences
